APPLY HAEMOSTATIC FIRST PRINCIPLES TO EXTERNAL/ COMPRESSIBLE HAEMORRHAGE

DIRECT PRESSURE

ELEVATION

SWABS/PACKS

HAEMOSTATIC DRESSINGS

FRACTURE SPLINTAGE

TRANEXAMIC ACID I5MG/KG (MAX IG) WITHIN IST HOUR

INITIAL BLOOD TRANSFUSION

COMMENCE TRANSFUSION OF IOML/KG RED CELLS VIA
BLOOD WARMER
SEND FBC, CLOTTING AND CROSS-MATCH TO LABS

TRANSFUSION ADJUNCTS

CONSIDER FFP: I5ML/KG
CONSIDER PLATELETS: I5ML/KG
CONSIDER CRYOPRECIPITATE: 5ML/KG
CONSIDER CALCIUM GLUCONATE 0.5ML/KG

DEFINITIVE HAEMORRHAGE CONTROL

SURGICAL REVIEW ± INTERVENTION
IMAGING
INTERVENTIONAL RADIOLOGY

COMPLETE BLOOD TRACEBILITY DOCUMENTATION STAND DOWN MAJOR HAEMORRHAGE CALL WITH BTS WHEN APPROPRIATE
